Phillipians 2:15-16

With NASA being in our backyard, one wonderful part of our daily life is that we are very used to the concept of looking up into space. Many just simply stand outside in their driveway to watch the latest shuttle or rocket. Others head out to the Kennedy Space Center and try to experience it up close. Still others work there!

Our theme for the SELC Luther League gathering we just hosted was "Shine like Stars" based on Philippians 2. In this day and age, we probably don't watch the stars up in the sky very much. Between the pollution and the lights, it can be hard to see the stars. But I hope we still have a curiosity and a desire to explore outer space. And I hope we have a passion and a desire to explore this world so that we can share Christ.

What is harder: To go to the moon or to live a life of faith? It may sound like a silly question, but you want to know the sad thing? Most Christians struggle greatly with faith. Why do we feel this way? Why can

we not shine brightly in the light

of Christ?

Philippians 2:14-18

Do everything without complaining or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe as you hold out the word of life—in order that I may boast on the day of Christ that I did not run or labor for nothing. But even if I am being poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you. So you too should be glad and rejoice with me.

Well, we can learn a couple of astronomy lessons here with faith applications:

- 1) Stars stop shining when they run out of fuel. Keep refueling in God's Word or you may burn out!
- 2) You can't see a star unless you look up. You can't find the answers to life's problems unless you look to God.

Calling All Volunteers


