With funding from Thrivent Financial Services and in partnership with Messiah Lutheran we will also have a hand's on service project at the South Brevard Sharing Center on July 7. In August we are collecting new backpacks & school supplies for the upcoming school year. The supplies will be delivered to the South Brevard Sharing Center. Note that August 12 – 14 is tax free on school supplies under \$15 and clothing under \$75 (a 6.5 % savings).






#### Faith Talk Tips
